REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

Regular registration will be conducted during business hours beginning November 18 with extended hours on Thursday, January 2, 10:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m. Students registering after January 9 will be considered "late" registrants and will incur a late fee. This includes registrations for all Module A courses.

RETURNING STUDENTS

Returning students from the last two semesters are encouraged to register through Oasis, (Student Information System), even for those on the payment plan. Any and all registration activity (using any method) must include complete information and will only be finalized with appropriate payment for fees and tuition.

NEW STUDENTS

New students must submit a completed application with personal testimony and application fee prior to registration. Institute, College, and Seminary applications should be submitted by Thursday, January 9, 2025 for proper processing. Requests for the online application and information may be submitted to the Administrative Offices through the Carver's website: www.CarverKC.org, by phone (816-333-1577, Ext. 7101), or in person. Late applications may affect the admittance and/or the registration process. New students will be contacted by the Registrar's Office to enroll.

PAYMENT PLAN

If you qualify for our tuition payment plan, <u>all</u> <u>fees and 25% of tuition</u> are due by January 10. The remaining balance is due in monthly payments on the 1st of each month through April. All balances must be paid before receiving a "Cleared for Finals" approval
