REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

Regular registration will be conducted during business hours beginning **Monday, November 3**, through **Friday, January 2, 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.** **Students registering after January 2 will be considered "late" registrants and will incur a late registration fee. This includes registrations for all Module A courses. All late registration ends January 23, 2026.**

RETURNING STUDENTS

Returning students from the last two semesters are encouraged to register through OasisSis, (Student Information System), even for those opting to use the tuition payment plan. **Any and all registration activity (using any method) must include complete information and will only be finalized with appropriate payment for fees and tuition.**

NEW STUDENTS

New students must submit an application with personal testimony and application fee prior to registration. **The application for Institute, College, and Seminary should be submitted by Thursday, January 8, 2026 for proper processing.** Requests for the online application and information may be submitted to the Administrative Offices through Carver's website: CarverKC.edu, by phone (816-333-1577, Ext. 7101), or in person. Late applications may affect the admittance and/or the registration process. **New students will be contacted by the Registrar's Office to enroll.**

PAYMENT PLAN

If you choose to use our Tuition Payment Plan, all fees and 25% of tuition are due by January 6. The remaining balance is due in monthly payments on the 1st of each month through **April. All balances must be paid before receiving a "Cleared for Finals" approval.**
